IV. CANCELLATION FEES

If a student wants to **cancel** a course, one must do so **in writing**. One may cancel on the following conditions, with a notice before the course begins:

- 1. more than 15 working days (Monday Friday): no penalty
- 2. 6 working days to 15 working days: 50% penalty
- 3. less than 6 working days: 100% penalty
- 4. A student may also **postpone** a course and take it within a year from the original starting date.
- 5. Regarding accommodation, if one cancels less than 5 working days before the arrival date, one must pay for 1 week's accommodation.

V. ISSUE OF VISAS

- We support students who need a VISA as much as we can by giving them relative advice
- If requested, we may provide students with a letter of acceptance (provided that they have paid the total of fees before we send it)
- If students are refused the issue of VISA and wish to have a refund of the fees they should send us the respective refusal letter of the Greek Consulate. In such case they will be entitled for a 90% refund.
- They will be also charged with the applicable bank transfer cost.

VI. NOTES

- 1. Course registration and accommodation bookings for all Schools are taken care by the Athens's School.
- 2. In case that the student's level cannot be matched with that of our other classes, we will offer him/her one to one tuition, but at reduced hours (50% of the lessons). We will also give him/her extra work in the library, so as to move faster.
- 3. One teaching hour is 50 minutes.
