IV. CANCELLATION FEES

If a student wants to **cancel** a course, one must do so **in writing**. One may cancel on the following conditions, with a notice before the course begins:

1. more than 15 working days (Monday - Friday): **no penalty**
2. 6 working days to 15 working days: **50% penalty**
3. less than 6 working days: **100% penalty**
4. A student may also **postpone** a course and take it within a year from the original starting date.
5. Regarding accommodation, if one cancels less than 5 working days before the arrival date, one must pay for 1 week's accommodation.

V. ISSUE OF VISAS

- We support students who need a VISA as much as we can by giving them relative advice
- If requested, we may provide students with a letter of acceptance (provided that they have paid the total of fees before we send it)
- If students are refused the issue of VISA and wish to have a refund of the fees they should send us the respective refusal letter of the Greek Consulate. In such case they will be entitled for a 90% refund.
- They will be also charged with the applicable bank transfer cost.

VI. NOTES

1. Course registration and accommodation bookings for all Schools are taken care by the Athens's School.
2. In case that the student's level cannot be matched with that of our other classes, we will offer him/her one to one tuition, but at reduced hours (50% of the lessons). We will also give him/her extra work in the library, so as to move faster.
